




# Florence Parks & Facilities

South Fork Park has activities your whole family will enjoy.

## **Florence/Boone County Skate Park**

This 22,000-square-foot park is designed for in-line skates, roller blades and skateboards. *Ewing Boulevard at KY-18 (Burlington Pike).*

## **Florence Nature Park**

Florence Nature Park is 15.64 acres, featuring 2,800 linear feet of paved walking trails. There is also an open-air gazebo available to rent at no charge and is perfect for weddings, reunions, graduation parties and more. And children enjoy climbing on the large, granite animals donated by Florence Mall. *Located on U.S. Highway 25 (Dixie Highway) off Banklick Street.*

## **Evelyn M. Kalb Gathering House**

The Evelyn M. Kalb Gathering House, a former residence was renovated into a public space, located at Florence Nature Park is rented to the public for parties or special occasions, such as weddings, birthdays or other private parties. *Capacity: 67 people with seating for 28.*

## **KY-18 Tennis Courts**

Two city tennis courts are available for one hour for singles and two hours for doubles. *Located next to Boone County High School on KY-18 (Burlington Pike).*

## **Lincoln Woods Park**

This 15-acre park has two tennis courts, a rubber-surface playground and swing sets, ball fields, a picnic shelter, grills, restrooms and more. *Located on City Park Drive, entrances on Rosetta and Surfwood drives.*

### Orleans Park

This 11-acre park features a stocked lake for fishing, playground with a swing set with nearby benches, bridge, shelter, basketball court, paved walking trail, bridge, tennis court, sand volleyball court, restroom, grill, drinking fountain, athletic field and sled hill. *Located in the Orleans North subdivision on the west side of the City.*

### South Fork Park

South Fork Park is 42 acres of fun and features an earthen sculpture play area, nautical-themed playground with two age-appropriate play structures, swing set, sand volleyball court, basketball court, pedestrian bridge, 2,720 linear feet of bike path, natural wooded and meadow areas, shelter, grill, drinking fountain, restroom and parking lot. *South Fork Park Drive.*

### Stringtown Park

This eight-acre park features two play structures, a climbing apparatus, swing set, basketball court, sand volleyball court, cornhole sets (bring your own bags), shelter, grill, seat wall, exercise stations, paved walking trail, benches, restroom, drinking fountains, open green space and parking lot.

*Located on KY-18 between Kathryn and Wallace avenues.*

### Walnut Creek Park

This 2.5-acre park features one ball field and open play area. *Access off Cedar Wood Circle on a concrete path via an easement.*

### Niblack Memorial Park

This future 4.5-acre neighborhood park features the Florence Senior Activity Center, a walking path. *Take U.S. 42 to Niblack Memorial Drive, next to the Boone County Public Library.*

# Off to a Running Start

THE INAUGURAL HONOR RUN HALF MARATHON WAS A SUCCESS, RAISING THOUSANDS TO HELP LOCAL VETERANS

**T**he city of Florence hosted the inaugural Honor Run Half Marathon and two-person relay. Despite the cold, the event sold out with 1,100 runners in the half marathon and 50 teams in the two-person relay.

"To sell out in our first year and to be able to raise \$27,000 for Honor Flight Tri-State and fill half of a plane full of veterans is an outstanding accomplishment and one that we are proud of," says Scott Spicher, the race's executive director.

Dr. Robert Tagher, local pediatrician and race participant, was really impressed with the event.

"I thought it was great," he says. "It went off without a hitch. It was well organized [and] a great course."

The Honor Run's proceeds went to Honor Flight Tri-State to help send local veterans, who served in World War II, The Korean and Vietnam wars, to Washington D.C. to see their respective memorials.

The race started and finished underneath the Florence Y'All water tower, taking runners on a foot tour of Florence landmarks, such as the Mall Road and Houston Road business districts, Turfway Park, and even inside the airport.

The next Honor Run and two-person relay is Nov.15, 2015, so mark your calendars.

"We want to double our attendance and our donation so we can fund an entire plane full of veterans," says Spicher.

Tagher believes that won't be an issue. "They will hit their goal," he says. "It was

# Advanced Developments

## Mall Road District

Florence Heights along Mall Road has two new anchor tenants: Costco and Menards.

**M**ore businesses are joining the already 2,500-plus companies located in the city of Florence. Announced in October 2014, Costco and Menards will be the new anchor tenants at Florence Heights, the 63-acre site commonly called Berkshire Farm. Planet Fitness is also expected to join the \$50 million development along the Mall Road retail corridor at the northwest corner of Interstates 71-75 and U.S. 42.

“We have a very diversified economy,” says Florence Mayor Diane Whalen. “And retail is an important quality-of-life issue that our residents, businesses and visitors love. The addition of new retailers not only to Florence, but to all of Northern Kentucky, will continue to bring people to our city where they know they will be able to find everything that they need or want.”

Finally breaking ground in October 2014, the city has wanted to develop the Florence Heights’ land, which is east of Mall Road and south of Florence Mall, since 1974. Mall Road KY LLC will develop the property, which was previously owned by Joseph C. Berkshire and Frances Berkshire.

“During my time as mayor, we’ve had the desire to see the property purchased and developed with a master plan in mind, rather than in smaller parcels that could take years to complete,” says Mayor Whalen, who starts her fifth term and 17th year in 2015.

Florence, and Northern Kentucky, receives two “firsts” with the addition of Costco and Menards; there are only two other Costcos and two other Menards in Greater Cincinnati.

“This property is the last remaining major tract of land in the Mall Road corridor,” adds Mayor Whalen.

In fall 2015, residents and visitors to Costco can expect 135,000 square feet of space piled high with bulk items. And Menards, the family-owned home improvement stores, aims for a spring 2016 completion date with its new 170,000-square-foot building.

Florence Heights has two remaining out-lots facing Mall Road, one 2.4 acres and the other 2 acres, and the city has a preferred list of businesses they want to move in, such as restaurants. There is also a possible 10 acres for retail and office use, and even a hotel. Over the next 30 years, the developers project that Florence Heights will generate \$17 million in local taxes, \$3 million in property taxes and \$8 million in payroll taxes for the city and Boone County, as well as \$6.5 million for the schools.

“It will also be key to the continued redevelopment and expansion decisions of the current retail base,” says Mayor Whalen. “It’s a case of good development increasing the value of all stakeholders in the area.” ■


